LSC School Superintendent Dr. Eiler to be Honored at Arbor Day Event

Lafayette School Corp. Superintendent, Dr. Ed Eiler, will attend Tree Lafayette's Arbor Day planting on Saturday, May 5, 2012. The gathering will take place at the flagpole area of Tecumseh Junior High School at 9 a.m. A special presentation will be made by Kay Walton, president of the LSC school board, to honor Dr. Eiler for his years of service to the Lafayette School Corp. and to the Greater Lafayette area. During the Arbor Day event, Tree Lafayette plans to plant at least 71 trees, and one of those will be the 1,500th tree that has been planted by the organization since its inception in 1993. The 1,500th tree will be planted in Eiler's honor with the dedication by Walton during the event. As a souvenir to remember Tree Lafayette's Arbor Day, t-shirts designed by students at Jefferson High School will be given to volunteers.

"We are short volunteers this year, so if you are free, bring some friends," says Tree Lafayette President Larry Rose. "The holes will be dug, and we will drive the stakes, and tie the straps. All volunteers do is drop the tree in the hole, remove the cage and burlap, and put in some soil and mulch. We provide the tools and the supervisor."
